

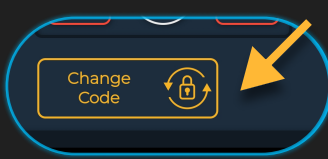
VERIFICATION

The two types of verification available in the driver are **Button** and **Auto**. As the names suggest the **Button** requires a click for verification to occur. **Auto** verification occurs when the length of the entered code matched the correct code. **Auto** type is not compatible with **Code Match** code type.

Button

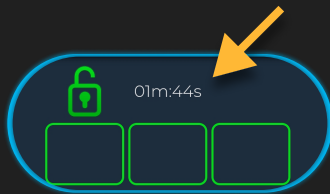

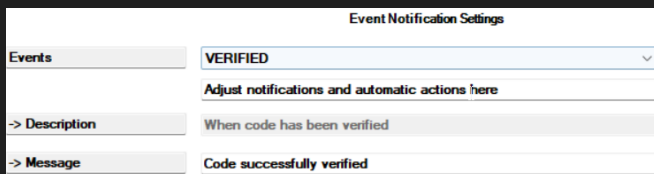
VERIFY TIME

Some code types require a time to be set that determines the length of verification. This setting is not applicable with **Toggle** or **Code Match** code types.



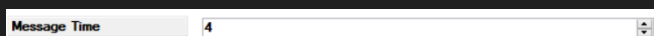
MESSAGES

Dashboard messages are set in the corresponding events under **Event Notification Settings**



MESSAGE TIME

The **Message Time** setting determines how long every message is displayed on the dashboard.



BUTTON TEXT

The **Button Text** setting allows you to customize the text displayed in the verification button. This setting is only used with **Button** type verification.



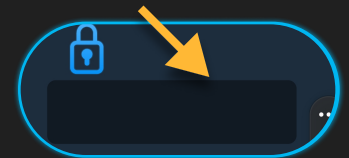
SHOW LENGTH

The dashboard can hide or display the length of the code. Though hiding the length may be more secure showing the length may be helpful of the user.

Show Length



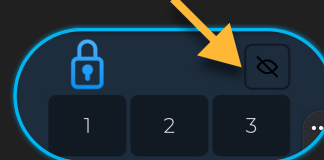
Hide Length



SHOW/HIDE CODE

When entering the code the user have the ability to **Show/Hide** the entered values. This feature can prevent code exposure from shoulder surfing. The code always starts hidden.

MISSING CODE

During initial installation and after clearing the code from the driver certain code types will prompt the user to set the code.
